In 2021, The Archie Edwards Blues Heritage Foundation continued to modify regular activities as well as special events. Weather permitting, jams were conducted outdoors and two guitar workshops were held virtually. We

As a step toward building a greater youth education effort, on December 13, the Foundation made a \$400 donation to the Northwestern High School (NWHS) located near the Foundation's

headquarters in Hyattsville, Maryland. The funds will support the school's music library and to build a partnership with the school and its performing arts department. Once normal activities resume, an exchange program will be developed between the school and the Foundation.

Looking ahead to 2022, the AEBHF hopes to put the pandemic behind us restart all of our existing programs. We expect, of course, to continue with the Saturday jams, reestablish our monthly open mics, and have a robust concert and workshop series.

All of our activities are made possible through help of our Board of Directors and volunteers.
